

HAGSHAW HILL WINDFARM



The windfarm is located on grass uplands 2 miles from Douglas in Lanarkshire. The site has 26 Bonus 600kW wind turbines and was commissioned in 1995. ScottishPower purchased the windfarm in 1996.

- Number of Turbines: 26

It has been operational since November 1995 and consists of 26 Bonus turbines, each rated at 600kW, giving a total capacity of 15.6MW. It was developed by TriGen Ltd and is operated by Windfarm Management Services Ltd on behalf of Scottish Power.

This was the first operational wind farm in Scotland under the Scottish Renewables Obligation round one. This is also the first operational site for the Bonus 600 in the UK.

The project created 50 local jobs during construction and more than £2.5 million of business was placed with local firms.
